Becherglas

A beaker is a cylindrical container with a flat bottom and a small spout for pouring. It is used in various ways and is therefore available in a wide range of sizes.





A beaker is used e.g. to collect and mix liquids. Likewise, it can be helpful when preparing solutions as the content can easily be stirred with a glass rod or a stirring bar due to the large opening.



Most beakers are made of borosilicate glass, which makes them resistant to heat and most chemicals.

Accordingly, the heating of a solution in a beaker with a gas burner (shown here with boiling stones on a tripod) is no problem.
