Septum

A septum is an air-tight seal that enables the removal or addition of substances with the help of a syringe and canula.



To seal a flask, the septum is first placed on the flask (left) and then flipped over the ground-glass joint (right).







Using a canula, the septum can be pierced and substance removed. When doing this, it is important use a second canula for pressure equalization.
